Civil Judge, Bhongir passed judgment and

preliminary decree in favour of the petitioner allotted one such share in

"Chapter II-A Succession by Survivorship - Objects & Reasons held that — The Hindu Succession Act, 1956 governs the property rights of Hindus and provides for devolution of property. Women are not members of the coparcenary under the Hindu Mitakshara Law and therefore, they are not entitled to claim partition in coparcenary property, and such exclusion of daughters has led to the creation of socially pernicious dowry system with its attendant social ills. In order to eradicate this ill by positive means which will simultaneously ameliorate the conditions of women in Hindu Society. It is proposed to confer equal rights on Hindu Women along with the male members so as to achieve the constitutional mandate of equality by suitably amending the said Act. (Vide I-A Bill No. 26 of 1985 published in AP Gazette Part IV-A (E.O) dated 05-09-1985).

The applicant submits that the Government of A.P. amended section A.P. Act no. 13/1986 with effect from 05-09-1985, subsequently, the Hindu Succession Act, 2005, Act No. 39/2005, dated 05-09-2005 came into force by birth become same as son in coparcenary in property, the petitioner acquired right over property.

Golden Tourist Resorts & Development Private Limited created fake document with collusion of one Mohan Raj and others and Vijaya Lakshmi and others and Salla Ram Reddy created fake registered sale deed, therefore, the applicant and their family members compelled to filed the partition suit before the Hon'ble V Prl. Civil Judge, Bhongir, the same was declared by the Hon'ble court and delivered physical possession by the Advocate Commissioner fixed boundaries with support of the Mandal Surveyor drafted the location sketch this evidence issued by the Mandal Surveyor allotted one such share to the petitioner land an extent of Ac 05-30 gts out of AC 34-20 gts acquired under coparcenary rights.
 - The applicant submits that from the date of delivered of physical possession by the Advocate Commissioner, the applicant cultivating the land as absolute owner and lawful possessor of the land due to the Covid-19, the Hon'ble Supreme Court suspended court works followed by the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana and sub-ordinate judiciary. 

Golden Tourist Resorts & Development Private Limited received the court summons and notices and failed to appear before the court, they have issued exparte, the Hon'ble court passed judgment and preliminary decree partition in suit OS No. 136/2016.

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The applicant submits subsequently, the Hon'ble court appointed the advocate commissioner in IA No. 526/2018 in OS No. 136/2016 issued warrant and proceeding of advocate commissioner in pursuance by the Hon'ble court on 22-05-2019 the advocate commissioner issued notices to the advocate and plaintiff and defendants in the said suit on 09-08-2019 and Mandal Surveyor, Bibi Nagar Mandal on 24-08-2019 fixed date of warrant at 11 am, notices which is evidence from the proceeding issued by the Advocate Commissioner allotted item no. 1 to the plaintiff - G. Mangamma in Sy. No. 19, an extent of Ac 05-14 gts and in Sy. No 20 an extent of Ac 00-16 gts in total admeasuring AC 05-30 gts, item no. 2 to the defendant no. 3 - G. Balamma in Sy. No. 20, an extent of Ac 05-30gts, item no. 3 to the defendant no. 4 - B. Suvarna in Sy. No. 20, an extent of Ac 01-06 gts and Sy. No. 21 an extent of Ac 04-24 gts in total admeasuring AC 05-30 gts, item no. 4 to the defendant no. 5 - P. Padma in Sy. No. 21, an extent of Ac 05-30 gts, item no. 5 to the defendant no. 2 - B. Santosh in Sy. No. 21, an extent of Ac 05-30 gts, and item no. 6 to the defendant no. 1 -B. Mallesh in Sy. No. 21, an extent of Ac 00-10 gts, and in Sy. No. 44 an extent of Ac 05-20 gts in total admeasuring AC 05-30 gts, which is evidence from the proceedings of advocate commissioner in IA No. 526/2018 in OS No. 136/2016, notices received by the parties of the above said suit. True copy of notice given by Advocate Commissioner to the parties in IA No. 526/2018 in OS No. 136/2016 dated 09.08.2019 before V Addl. District Judge, Bhongir is annexed herewith as ANNEXURE A-9. The applicant submits that therefore, the documents created by them without knowledge of the applicant intending to grab the land of B. Rajaiah after death of B. Rajaiah the applicant compelled to approach the Mandal Revenue authorities for creating proceedings under grievance of Virasath as class – I legal heir under section 8 – Hindu Succession Act, this Hon'ble court rendered land mark judgment by birth the daughter are entitled to equal share in compliance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment, the trial court and Hon'ble V Prl. Civil Judge, Bhongir passed judgment and preliminary decree in favour of the petitioner allotted one such share in decision reported 2020 5 ALT 1 SC equal rights to daughter under co-parcenary property.

"Chapter II-A Succession by Survivorship - Objects & Reasons held that — The Hindu Succession Act, 1956 governs the property rights of Hindus and provides for devolution of property. Women are not members of the coparcenary under the Hindu Mitakshara Law and therefore, they are not entitled to claim partition in coparcenary property, and such exclusion of daughters has led to the creation of socially pernicious dowry system with its attendant social ills. In order to eradicate this ill by positive

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means which will simultaneously ameliorate the conditions of women in Hindu Society. It is proposed to confer equal rights on Hindu Women along with the male members so as to achieve the constitutional mandate of equality by suitably amending the said Act. (Vide I-A Bill No. 26 of 1985 published in AP Gazette Part IV-A (E.O) dated 05-09-1985).

- The applicant submits that the Government of A.P. amended section A.P. Act no. 13/1986 with effect from 05-09-1985, subsequently, the Hindu Succession Act, 2005, Act No. 39/2005, dated 05-09-2005 came into force by birth become same as son in coparcenary in property, the petitioner acquired right over property.
- The applicant submits that the respondent M/s. Golden Forest (India) Private Limited and M/s. Golden Tourist Resorts & Development Private Limited created fake document with collusion of one Mohan Raj and others and Vijaya Lakshmi and others and Salla Ram Reddy created fake registered sale deed therefore, the applicant and their family members compelled to filed the partition suit before the Hon'ble V Prl. Civil Judge, Bhongir, the same was declared by the Hon'ble court and delivered physical possession by the Advocate Commissioner fixed boundaries with support of the Mandal Surveyor drafted the location sketch this evidence issued by the Mandal Surveyor allotted one such share to the petitioner land an extent of Ac 05-30 gts out of AC 34-20 gts acquired under coparcenary rights.

- The applicant submits that from the date of delivered of physical possession by the Advocate Commissioner, the petitioner cultivating the land as absolute owner and lawful possessor of the land due to the Covid-19, this Hon'ble Court suspended court works followed by the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana and sub-ordinate judiciary. Therefore, final decree is not yet passed by the Hon'ble V Prl. Civil Judge, Bhongir though the Advocate Commissioner submitted the report and conducted the matter and final decree may be passed as early as possible.
- The applicant submits that applicant is compelled to file the implead petition for seeking the deletion of item no. 6,7,8 from M/s. Golden Forest (India) Private Limited and M/s. Golden Tourist Resorts & Development Private Limited, the land acquired by the plaintiff through court judgment and decree. Therefore, the petition filed before this Hon'ble court appropriate direction for passing orders on above said land details are not binding on the applicant.

PRAYER *

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble court may be pleased to

(a). direct the respondents to remove/delete the item no. 4, 6,7,8 from M/s.

Golden Forest (India) Private Limited and M/s. Golden Tourist Resorts &

Development Private Limited which belongs to applicant herein; and/or

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(b). pass any other order which the Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.
