JUDGEMENT

Tehsildar Dehradun while submitting the report has mentioned that Shri R.K. Syal and his family members, in the names of different companies related to Golden Forest India Limited, have purchased a huge land from different Khata on the basis of registered sale deed in different village while violating the provision under Section 154(1) of the Z.A. Act. Shri R.K. Syal and his family members in violation of the prohibitions under Section 154(1) of Z.A. Act have purchased lands more than 12 ½ acres and they are in possession

on site. Alongwith his report the copies of Khatauni of lands in question and the details of lands in question have been produced, wherein it has been mentioned that Shri R.K. Syal and his family members have purchased lands in village Bhandariwala area 0.202 Hect. in the name of Ku. Pamela Syal and in village Gujarada Mansin area 0.283 Hect. in village Nooriwala area 0.302 Hect. and in village Asthal area 0.332 Hect. in the name of Golden Forest India Limited Chandigarh, in village Danda Ghoran area 1.004 Hect., in Bhandariwala Maichak area 0.256 Hect., in village Gujarami area 1.298 Hect., in village Gujarada Mansingh area 1.081 Hect., in village Sonyowal Ghoran area 3.149 Hect., in Ghoran Khas area 1.161 Hect., in Danda Lakhaundmaichak area 4.513 Hect. lands in the name of Golden Forest India Limited through R.K. Syal and in village Bajhet area 1.951 Hect. in the name of Golden Forest through Ku. Pamela Syal and in village Jhajara area 1.603 Hect. in village Bajhet area 1.840 Hect., in village Danda Nooriwala area 194 Hect., in village Bhinswara Gaon area 6.093 Hect., Aghoiwala area 4.669 Hect., in village Mothariwala area 0.231

Since the purchaser side has purchased the lands more than the limit prescribed under Section 154(1) of Z.A. Act, therefore, proceeding under Section 166/167 Z.A. Act be instituted.

I have perused the evidence available on record and has perused the report of Tehsildar Dehradun. From the evidence available it is clear that the purchasers have purchased the lands in different villages from different Sankramakya Bhumidhars in different names and with the purchaser there is

more land than the limit prescribed under Section 154(1) of Z.A. Act. Therefore for vesting of the said remaining land into State Government now institution of proceeding u/s 166/167 of Z.A. Act is necessary. The purchaser side has purchased total 48.386 Hect. land. In other words the purchaser has acquired land more than 12 ½ acres. The said excessive purchased land in violation of provision under Z.A. Act are presumed to be vested into State Government under Section 166 of Z.A. Act free from all encumbrances. Probably to save from this provision, the purchaser side has willfully has not done the proceeding for mutation of lands purchased into their names and the lands in questions are still have been recorded in the different Khatedars in the revenue record which is wrong. Out of the aforesaid total purchased land in the name of purchaser side, as per rule, total 12 ½ acres lands are fit to be left and remaining lands are justified to be vested in the State Government and since the case in question is an urgent case and there is every possibility of misappropriation of land in this lands. Therefore, in the interest of justice it

is necessary to vest these remaining land into the State Government with immediate effect.

2. In view of this fact and in light of the decision taken at the level of government I have been directed to state that under provisions in the Government Order No. 260/Vitta Anubhag-3/2002 Date 15.02.02, Government Order No. 111/XXVII(7) 50(39)/2015/2014 date 09.07.2015, Government Order No. 1887/XVIII(II)/2015-18(169)/2015 date 30 July, 2015 of Finance Section-3, for establishment of "Science City" the Hon'ble Governor grants approval for allotment/transfer of land to the Science and Technology Department, Uttarakhand under the following terms conditions/prohibitions.

- (1) On the land there should not be any religious or historical importance structure.
- (2) The project for which land is being transferred should be an approved project and for this consent of government has been obtained.
- (3) If the transferred land is used for the purpose different from for the proposed activity then for that purpose fresh approval has to be obtained from the original department.
- (4) If there has not been further requirement of land or the transferred land has not been taken into use for the proposed activity for a period of 3 years then the same will automatically vest into the original department.
- (5) The land cannot be transferred to any other person, institution, Samiti or department for the purpose other than the purpose for which land is being transferred

without consent of the original department.

- (6) After fulfillment of requirement for which the land is being allotted, if land remains then the original department will have right to return it back.
- (7) In case of application of provision of Forest Conservation Act on the land in question, change of land use for non forest activities will be applicable only when under the said Act permission is being obtained from the prescribed authority under the said Act.
- (8) Prior to allotment of land compliance of Section 132 of Zamindari Abolition and Land Reforms Act and other relevant provisions will be ensured by the District Collector.
- (9) In this regard compliance of order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in Civil Appeal No. 1132/2011 (S.L.P.)/(C) No. 3109/2011 Shri Jagpal Singh and Ors. Versus State of Punjab and Ors. And other relevant directions have to be ensured.

(10) On completion of the period of allotment or due to violation of any of the aforesaid conditions at Sl. Nos. 01 to 09, the land in question alongwith structure will vest into the Revenue Department, for which no compensation will be payable.

Kindly in this regard ensure further action as per rule and copy of order issued at the level of District in light of government order may kindly be made available to the Government.

**RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH**

1. The Committee has filed an IA no. 145178 of 2019 seeking direction in respect of surplus lands matter pertaining to the Golden Forests Group Companies in the state of Uttarakhand. The Hon'ble Court has been pleased to issue notice. State of Uttarakhand has filed reply and the Committee-GFIL has filed

rejoinder. On a direction made by the Hon'ble Court, Committee has also filed proposed issue.

2. At the time of filing of IA No. 145178 of 2019, The Committee had knowledge of 7 main cases no. 30,33 to 37 & 39 of 1996-97 which were decided by the Assistant Collector 1st Class-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate Dehradun on 21.08.1997 under Sections 154(1) of the Uttar Pradesh Zamindari Abolition and Land Reforms Act, 1950. By the said order the land purchased by the Golden Forests Companies were declared surplus and excess land was directed to be vested in the Government of Uttarakhand.
3. The Committee has recently, on 27.3.2021, come to know about one more order was passed by the Additional Collector, Dehradun on 2.6.2003 vide which lands of the Golden Forests Group companies have been declared surplus. This order was passed on 21 similar matters collectively. The Committee has taken certified copy of the order dated 2.6.2003 on 27.3.2021. The English translation of order dated 2.6.2003 is annexed as **Annexure A-1 (Pg \_\_\_\_ to Pg \_\_\_\_)**
4. From the record, it is found that the order dated 2.6.2003 passed by the Additional Collector, Dehradun was not contested by the Golden Forests Companies may be for the reasons that the directors of the companies were lodged in jail in Dec 2000.

However, it has also come to knowledge of the Committee that High Court of Uttarakhand has vide order dated 27.03.2014 set aside order dated 02.06.2003 passed by Additional Collector Dehradun and order dated 28.07.2003 passed by the Commissioner. At present the matter is before Additional Collector Dehradun. Copy of order dated 27.03.2014 passed by High Court of Uttarakhand is annexed as **Annexure A-2** (Pg\_\_ to Pg\_\_).

5. Since the order has similar effect on the lands of Golden Forests Group companies in the state of Uttarakhand, it is essential that orders to be passed by this Hon'ble Court in the IA No. 145178 of 2019 in 7 matters are applicable to the 21 matter on which order dated 2.6.2003 was passed.
6. Therefore, in view the above, it is prayed that:
  - a) the English translation of order dated 2.6.2003 (Annexure A-1) may please be taken on record;
  - b) the orders to be passed in IA No. 145178 of 2019 may please be made applicable to the 21 matters on which order dated 2.6.2003 was passed by the Assistant Collector, Dehradun, and
  - c) Pass any other order which deemed fit and proper

Certified copy of the order dated 02.06.2003 passed by the learned court of Assistant Collector 1<sup>st</sup> Grade, Vikasnagar.

The present case has been presented on the different dates in the month of September 1997 after the report submitted by Tehsildar. The Golden Forest Company India Limited without taking the permission of government has acquired land in huge quantity in the area of villages Bairagi Wala, Khushhalpur, Ghamole, Sheesham Bada, Central Hope Town, Lakhan Wala, Jhajra, Suddhowala, East Hopetown, Rampur, Jassowala and Kakrani, which comes to 12.50 acres, which is the gross



violation of section 154(1) of the Uttar Pradesh Zimidara Abolition and Land Reform Act. Thus, report has been presented.

The case has been registered notice has been issued to the opposite parties. from the side of opposite parties, Rajesh Pokhriyal advocate has been appeared some cases and Rajesh Garg advocate has appeared in some other cases and objections have been filed that the notices have been wrongly issued from the law perspective. Because every company has its own status, therefore the company has the right to acquire 12.50 acres land. Therefore, no company has



||

violated the provisions of the 154 of the Act.

No company is the associate company of Golden Forest Company. None of the companies have purchased more than 12. 50 acres land. Therefore, no company has violated the provisions of Section 154 of the Act. the opposite party after filing the objection joint the hearing open drone after time none has appeared on behalf of the opposite party.

Subodh Kumar Sharma district attorney has appeared on behalf of the state government. he has stated that this case is pending since many days the opposite party despite summoning not pursuing the case. It will be



appropriate that the opposite party may be informed through Publication in the newspaper. Because the opposite party has the information regarding this case since beginning, therefore there is no need providing them fresh information. The learned Court in the interest of Justice has provided another opportunity of hearing to the opposite party. but the opposite party did not file any objection till the date fixed. Therefore, the district attorney has stated that it will not be appropriate to provide more opportunity to the opposite party. Therefore, the case may kindly be decided by passing an ex-parte order.



Pursuing on behalf of the state government, he has led the arguments as under:

Golden Forest company has purchased land measuring 12.50 acres in the area of municipal committee of Dehradun add Tehsil Vikas Nagar, is the violation of Section 154 of Uttar Pradesh Zimidara Abolition and Land Reform Act Therefore the land has now been forfeited to the state government by virtue of sections 166/167 of the Act. Therefore, the entry may kindly be made in the revenue record in the name of state government. The land of other associate companies of Golden Forest company may also be attached in the land purchased by Golden Forest, because





these companies are the associate companies of Golden Forest.

In support of his arguments, the DGCR presented sufficient evidence which are available on the case file.

(i) In this regard the statement of record keeper and present Tehsildar quoted in the land Court. The concerned record keeper has confirmed the report in this Honorable Court.

(ii) in compliance of the order passed by the Honorable Court and it was passed on the request of DGCR, the Naib Tehsildar Vikasnagar has visited the village and recorded the statements of certain farmers who have sold the land and after



recording the statement, presented the same before this learned Court, which are available on the court file. In the statements, the farmers have admitted that they have sold their land to the Golden Forest company. (At Sr. No.5 on the file).

(iii) DGRC has given an application that Mr. N.P Gupta plaintiff witness number 1 is the employee of the Golden Forest company and his case file has been forwarded by the Commissioner Garhwal to the Pargana Adhikari Vikas Nagar for taking further action. He may kindly be summoned through this honorable court and he may kindly be considered as witness. On



05.05.2003 the order for submitting the case file have been passed and subsequently the case file has been received on 12.5.2003 which is enclosed with the present case file. The affidavit dated 05.05.2003 has been tendered by Mr. Gupta before the Pargana Adhikari is also attached with the present file.

On the basis of the record which has been presented by the plaintiff witness No.1, the DGRC has pleaded that the letter which has been written by Mr. Gupta to the Commissioner of Garhwal division with the request that the company in order to make the payment to its investors has allocated the land



situated in Sudhowala to its investor as per the enclosed list of investors. Therefore, as per the enclosed list. The record keeper while causing obstruction has said not to do any work on the land because certain land out of this land has been vested with the state government. They not do any work on this land. Photo copy of the identity card issued by the Golden Forest company attached. The Commissioner of Garhwal has passed order on 03.01.2002 on this letter and the same has been sent to the office of Additional Deputy Commissioner vide letter number 910.

The learned state counsel has pleaded that the proposal and the list of investor sent along with the above



said letter be considered as correct. The investors are related to Golden Forest company and the companies who have given proposals are also associated companies of the Golden Forest company. Therefore, all the lands of the above said companies may also be attached in the name of Golden Forest company under section 154 of the act.

Para no.3 of the affidavit presented by the PW-1 proves that the money of investors has been mainly invested in Golden Forest Company and its computerized receipts have been presented.

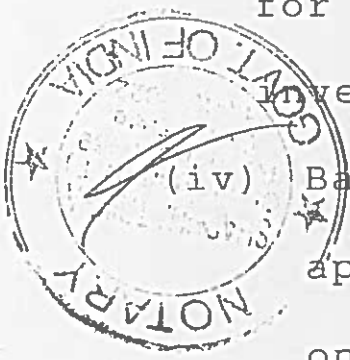
PW-1 has stated that the main object of the company was to collect



money from the investors and use the same for the growth of forest and for this object, the company had purchased land at a large extend. The company also got assistance from some of its associate companies for the purchase of the land. As per his statement, the company has as many as 113 associate companies. Dr. Niranjana Parsad, who is the Chief Development Advisor of the company and the company has also issued him identity card, copy of which is attached herewith. He has got invested an approximate amount of Rs.6 Crore from different investors. Affidavit is attached. From it is proved that:



- The investment has been made by the investors mainly in the Golden Forest Company.
- Company has purchased the land at large extent on different places and it has been purchased in the names of different associate companies.
- The main company is not enjoying good situation and the company has passed the above said resolution regarding the associate companies for the return of money of their investors.



(iv) Balwinderjit Sayal (PW-2) has appeared before the learned court on 12.05.2003 and tendered his affidavit, Article of Association of Golden Forest company, Article

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of Association along with details of the properties purchased by the different companies have been presented and the same are on the case file. Mr. Sayal has stated on oath that the company had appointed him in the year 1995 in the Dehradun Circle in the capacity of an employee.



To purchase the land for the Golden Forest company. To get execute the sale deed. To make entries in the revenue record. He has purchased approximate land measuring 150 acres in the name of main company as well as in the name of associate companies. The amount for the purchase of land was come Mandli from Golden Forest company



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through Bank draft. The main company had given directions to purchase the land and to get registered sale deed in the name of different companies. He doesn't have the knowledge whether the state government had given any permission to purchase the land more than 12.50 acres or not.

As per his statement all the investors have invested their money in main company Golden Forest Company and not any other company. In the recent time the associated companies are passing resolutions to allocate the land to the investors according to their investment.



From his statement as well as from the record presented, it is proved that:

As per the business of Golden Forest, the land has been purchased at the large extent in its name as well as in the name of its associated companies.

No permission has been taken from the government to purchase the land at the large extent.

Golden Forest company was fully aware that no company can purchase the land more than 12.50 acres. But this company in a well-planned manner did this to purchase the land by forming associate companies.



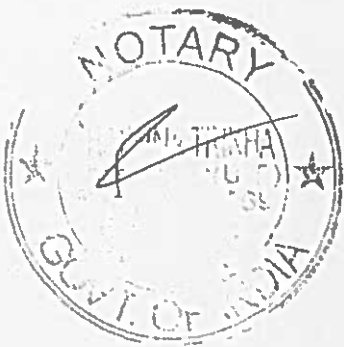
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The object of the Golden Forest since begging was to defeat the provisions of the land laws.

The amount for the purchase of the land was generated from Golden Forest company and the amount came to the Golden Forest company from the investors.

The land to the investors is being allocated by passing the resolutions of associated companies.

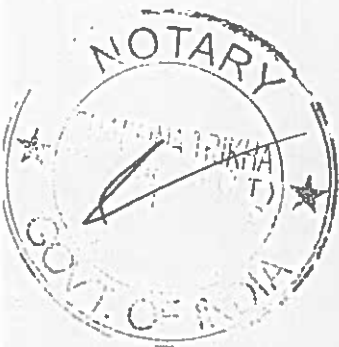
(iv) Regarding the sale deeds presented by PW1 and PW2 which are received by the company, in this regard the District Attorney has made request that if these details are certified, the sale deeds mentioned in this detail such as



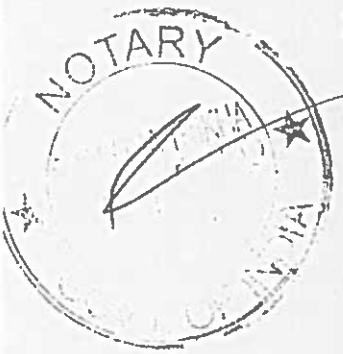

registration number, date of registration, purchasing company etc. will be available in the books of the Registration Office. If the above said details are certified by the Joint Registration Office, in that eventuality, it will be proved that the land is actually sold to the company. Therefore, due to violation of section 154(4), the whole land will be vested to the state government under section 166/167 of the Act. Therefore, the sale deeds may kindly be treated as sufficient evidence.

On 14.05.2003 and 15.05.2003, the Naib Tehsildar and District Attorney



(R) has inspected and examined the record in the office of Joint Sub Registrar Dehradun. During this inspection the record presented by the PW1 and PW2 has been found correct. Therefore, as the details, the dates and registration numbers are entered in the index and books in the office of Joint Registration Officer. On the basis of this, the Joint Registration Officer, Second, Dehradun has certified that the details of these sale seeds are entered as per rules in the record of this office. JB Singh, Joint Registration Officer has appeared in this court on 26.05.2003 and recorded his statement along with an affidavit that the documents which he has certified are true and correct and the



certified copy of sale deeds can be presented at the time of need. Therefore, from the attached documents, it is proved that the Golden Forest company as well as its associate companies I have purchased land at a large extent in Tehsil Vikasnagar. now because the above said list has been proved as correct, therefore it is clear that all the companies are the associate companies of the main company. in reference to the above cited circumstances, if any farmer or company says that he has not sold or purchased the above said land and, in that eventuality, the onus to prove lies on him. This list is available at serial number 6 on the case file.



In this regard many cases are pending and in all the cases, there is a single dispute that the land has been purchased by the associate companies of the Golden Forest Company or through their agents. In the Village Rampur Kallan, the land measuring 12.6650 hectare is in the name of associate companies of Golden Forest company and after transfer of land, the record is incorporated in the Khatoni. The copy of the Khatoni is annexed with the case file. In the cases bearing nos. 38/2000-01, 36/2000-01, 46/2000-01, 45/2000-01 the land measuring 17.45 acres by Golden T Resorts, land measuring 25.04 acre purchased by H.P.C Resort Limited, land measuring 23.08 acres has been purchased by Indian Overseas Peace



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Foundation Trust Limited as well as  
purchased by Ujjala Fincap, Eka Fincap,
